Region

The Marche region is located in central Italy, just north of Abruzzo. The various terroirs are influenced by the Apennines Mountains, the Adriatic Sea, the abundant rivers, and the rolling coastal hills.



Soil and Climate

This region's soil consists mostly of clay and limestone. The climate is variable with exceptional sunshine and plenty of rainfall. Warm coastal temperatures and cooler inland mountain air create the perfect conditions for the vines to thrive.

Winemaking

Old pergola vineyards harvested by hand by hand in the cooler hours of the day. After maceration the juice ferments on the skins in stainless steel tanks for 10/12 days at a controlled temperature of 25°C.

Sign: Dark deep intense magenta in color

Nose: Dusty strawberry and cocoa with a fresh vibrancy of earth. White floral and cigar box finishes off with traces of white chocolate and espresso.

Palate: Sweet notes of candied strawberry and plum. Savory tones of cherry tomato also lead into spice notes of cumin, white chocolate, toffee. Creamy round notes of sweet curry spice
