Bella Pazza Sangiovese

Region

Our Sangiovese is grown just outside the agriculture commune of Canosa Sannita in the Abruzzo region, south of Chieti City. Although Montepulciano is the dominant grape in the region, Sangiovese also thrives in this local terroir.



Soil and Climate

This region's soil consists mostly of clay and limestone. The climate is variable with exceptional sunshine and plenty of rainfall. Warm coastal temperatures and cooler inland mountain air create the perfect conditions for the vines to thrive.

Winemaking

Vineyards are located on hillsides at 400m above sea level. The training system is Pergola Abruzzese. Grapes are only picked by hand. After maceration the juice ferments on the skins in stainless steel tanks for 10/12 days at a controlled temperature of 25°C.
